

Fanal Ornaments

5 years +

What you Need

- Plywood shaped houses (available at craft stores like Michael's)
- Sharpie paint markers for decorating
- Parchment or translucent paper in your chosen color
- Glue gun and glue sticks
- Yarn (for hanging the ornaments)
- Tape
- Modge Podge or another sealer (for protection and shine)
- Scissors
- Optional: Watercolor cakes to stain the parchment paper for added color



What we will do

1. Decorate
 - a. Use Sharpie markers to decorate the plywood houses.
2. Attach Parchment
 - a. Cut parchment paper to fit the backs of the houses and tape it on.
3. Add Yarn
 - a. Cut 8-inch yarn pieces and glue them to the back for hanging.
4. Seal
 - a. Apply Modge Podge for a shiny finish and protection.
5. Hang on Tree
 - a. Place the ornaments on your tree so the lights shine through the parchment
